The following PHP-driven suite of applications were responsible for supporting many hundreds of users concurrently and deliver a wide array of interfaces including Websites, RESTful API's, Command Line Interfaces (CLI) and Socket Servers. Of the user-interface driven applications the XLIFF interchange format was used to allow localized data to support many different languages such as English, Spanish, Polish, French and Somali.

Order Pick Ticket Processor

This application consisted of a RESTful API, Web Admin and Application Server that heavily utilized message queueing over Redis and PHP Resque to allow an Order Management System (OMS) to deliver orders in real time for fulfillment. This system was responsible for validating, allocating, batching and delivering specifically formatted data-payloads to various Warehouse Management Systems.

Warehouse Control System Administration

This application allowed station leads and floor admins to monitor/manage system volume, track end-user performance and triage order exceptions through an easy to use, responsive-design website. The Warehouse Control System also had an API and Commands application that employs massive message queueing strategies. Responsible for a myriad of back-end tasks, the Commands application was also integrated with various Distribution Center PLC's such as conveyor and sortation systems.

Mobile

Taking advantage of the Motorola RhoElements Development Framework, this application provided a website driven tool-set to end-users via the Motorola wearable computers WT4090 & WT41N0. Through this application, end-users were able to perform tasks such as order picking, triage activities, as well as, many different types of inquiries throughout the distribution center.

Packing

This web application provided multiple packing interfaces such as gift-card-only packing, single-item-single-order bulk packing, single-order packing, and conveyor driven automated packing solutions such as document insertion and auto-bagging. It was a highly customizable and trackable web application that interfaces directly with a Manhattan Associates PkMS warehouse management system and systematically scan verified, weighed, packed, shipped and manifested order guided pick tickets.

iSeries API

This PHP application was deployed to an iSeries mainframe. Its main purpose was to provide an interface for external applications within our enterprise eco-system to access and execute CL/RPG programs within the iSeries environment.

Kiosk

This web application was a "low-level of authority" interface positioned throughout a distribution center to give end-users the ability to quickly perform a wide array of tasks such as triage order exceptions, order container management (bin/tote/carton/truck/gaylord) and inquiry screens against orders, order containers and shipping labels.

Store Fulfillment

This suite of applications consisted of an API, Web Admin, Application Server and Store Fulfillment Website. It allowed a client to use its network of brick-and-mortar Store Front locations as a hive warehouse and fulfill orders based on available inventory, customer proximity and other business rules of allocation. This application allowed a Store Front to self-fulfill orders via direct integration with FedEx, UPS and USPS. Also available was the ability to allow clients to manage "In Store Pick-Up" and "Local Delivery" types of orders. This application was used in many countries such as the United States of America, Mexico, England and Poland. The application was fully equipped to support localization of languages such as English, Spanish and Polish. The localization also accommodates legal requirements of some countries to record and print Fiscal Receipts for each box shipped. Some of the companies that have used this application are Toys R Us, Lowes, Army & Air Force Exchange Services, Spirit and Spencer's Gifts, Mills Fleet Farm and Yankee Candle.
